SNOW!

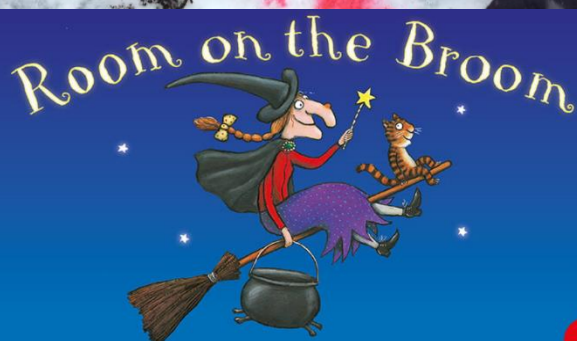
It has been snowy and Wren class have loved exploring this week. They have also started their block of forest schools. The best way to learn about the world is through hands on experience.
